Robert Walters Japan supports young artists on the global stage

The work will be exhibited at The National Art Center, Tokyo from August 11

Since its establishment in 2017 by Yuriko Yagi and Kazumasa Takada, the firm has been collaborating with artists and designers active around the world. They have won numerous awards, including the Grand Prize at Europe's largest art event in Copenhagen (2017). Respecting the diversity of society, they have created many works that incorporate and harmonize various elements of local culture, history, and politics.

About the exhibition: "The Matter of Facts"

The architectural installation was created using recycled paper, particularly printed materials

for events that were canceled or postponed due to the pandemic. This work, which is

comprised of an accumulation of printed matter that is a means of communicating "facts", is

an attempt to retain the urban memory of Covid-19 and newly capture the present place in

which we live. The exhibition will be integrated with the central information counter on the first

floor of The National Art Center, Tokyo.
